Homework Policy

Through this policy we aim to

- Ensure that parents have a clear understanding about expectations from themselves and the children.
- Provide opportunities for parents, children and the school to work in partnership.
- Encourage children to develop a positive attitude to working outside the classroom.
- Encourage progression towards independence and individual responsibility.
- Extend and support school learning.

Homework could include:

Regular reading - either aloud to an adult or (for fluent readers) silently. Discussion about the story, what has happened, what might happen next. Looking at words with particular letter patterns, rhyming words etc. Reading contact books can be used for comments by both home and school.

Spelling - looking for letter patterns in words, finding words with certain letter patterns, spelling lists to learn.

Finding information - as this occurs, depending on class topic, e.g. learning logs in Y1.

Occasional practical Mathematics activities eg number games, measuring, gathering information. Learning number facts including simple times tables (for Y2). Mathletics.
